

AP Exam ordering F.A.Q.'s

1. Where do I order AP exams?

Exam orders are placed online at <https://aptsusa.com/uhs/>

2. How Much are AP exams?

The cost of each AP® exam is \$95. A \$40 deposit is due for each exam by November 6, 2020.* The balance of fees are due by March 5, 2021.

3. What if I am in Econ and not sure if I want to take Micro or Macro?

Students should register for AP Micro this semester. If students decide to take AP Macro next semester, Mrs. Fernandez can switch your exam to AP Macro on her end. If students decide to take both, then students can register for AP Macro in January with no additional late fees.

4. What if I am in Calculus AB now but then switch to BC next semester?

If you place your order for calculus AB, but then switch next semester to BC, Mrs. Fernandez can switch your exam to BC. Place your order for Calculus AB this semester.

5. Where can I find if the college I plan on attending accepts AP Credit?

6. If I qualify for the Fee reduction code, do I still pay the \$40 deposit?

Your deposit due remains \$40 per exam, but you will enter your fee reduction code when prompted to your AP® exam deposit form submitted via the APTS website. This will modify your balance due in March.

7. What if I want to cancel My AP exams?

Students who initiated an exam order and decide to cancel, may do so through 11:59pm March 5, 2021 by emailing the APTS Cancellation Desk at cancel@aptsusa.com. Cancellation requests submitted on or before March 5, 2021 will be eligible for a refund of the base exam fees. A \$3 administrative fee will be deducted from the exam fee. Late registration fees and credit card processing fees are non-refundable

8. Which courses are Spring Semester courses?

AP Calculus BC and AP Macro. These students, and only these students, are eligible to submit exam fees and activate the exam on MyAP starting January 1, 2021 with no penalty fee.
